Dear Parents and Patrons of Kimberly School District,

I would like to welcome everyone back to another school year! The first day of school for students is **Monday, August 27, 2018**. Registration information is on the back side of this letter and can be found on our website. Middle and elementary school supplies lists are also available on the district website and high school teachers will notify students of their supply needs during the first day of class.

We ask that everyone take extra precaution before and after school for the safety of our children and pay special attention to pedestrians, bicyclists, runners, school zones, speed limits, and cross walks. Please slow down and move over for bicyclists, pedestrians, runners, and farm equipment. Please put phones away and pay attention to your surroundings.

With the addition of Stricker Elementary the districts transportation policies and procedures have changed. Specifically, parents may pick only one pick up and one drop off designation.
