Dear Parents and Patrons of Kimberly School District,

So much for not having much of a winter this year! I know the moisture was welcomed by our farmers, I am ready for longer and warmer days that are right around the corner.

Due to recent national tragic events many have contacted us regarding **school safety**. We live in a world in which we cannot guarantee that such an act of violence couldn't happen here. All staff members undergo active shooter training annually, we practice safety drills, and the administration participates in table top discussion with first responders in which our response to a variety of crisis' are discussed and analyzed. We do not share our specific plans as that would allow potential offenders the use of this information. Also, we encourage staff members to build a professional relationship with students and to be very vigilant in reporting any suspicious behaviors. Patrons can help us by reporting anything that appears suspicious. Lastly, we request that all visitors to our school's report to the office before proceeding into the building. I ask that visitors do not hassle staff members when directed to go to the office if you have not checked in, they are here to protect your children.

The Kimberly School District would like to thank Matthew Black for his service to the Kimberly School Board of Trustees. Unfortunately for us, Matthew and his family have moved from Kimberly which has created a **Zone 3 vacancy** on our school board.
