# Attendance tracker

- KHS has too many students that are chronically absent that affect academic achievement.
- Every Monday, students are keeping track of their own attendance using a spreadsheet with embedded formulas.
- KHS has a specific goal stating we want students to attend at least 162 days to attain a 95% attendance rate.

# Plan of Action

Science, Math, and ELA teachers of 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will do the following:

1. All junior teachers will complete the TA certification course by November 1 (30 minutes).
2. Shortened ISAT multiple choice section (SICA) in November or December.
3. Long version of the test with multiple choice and performance task in February (ICA).
4. Weekly warm up problems (printed off version).
5. Students in Math and ELA will take the Performance Task (PT) first prior to the Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) to receive overall scores sooner.
6. Inform parents and student of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade scores.
7. Incentivize students to give maximum effort (State and local).

# Incentive to give maximum effort

- Exempt students from Spring finals for scoring proficient or above in either Science, Math, or ELA.
- **CLASS OF 2025 GRADUATES CAN USE ISAT SCORES FOR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS**

The 2024/25 academic year is starting and for the first time, the Idaho State Board of Education's Idaho Campus Choice program will incorporate Idaho Standards Achievement Test (ISAT) results as part of the methodology used to determine whether graduating high school seniors are eligible for guaranteed acceptance to four, six or all eight of Idaho's public higher education institutions.
